Lt. Col. (Ret.) Brian
Birdwell and his wife,
Mel, are both survivors

of the terrorists' attacks on September 11, 2001. After hijacked American Airlines Flight 77 collided into the Pentagon, Brian was thrown to the ground and engulfed in flames. Burns consumed 60 percent of his body, nearly half were third degree. While Brian was fighting for his life and undergoing 30+ surgeries, intensive skin grafts and unbearable painful medical care, Mel was fighting to maintain the couple's faith and their family.

They believe Brian's life was spared for a purpose and delight in sharing this with others.
